





First Action: Home Energy Assessment








- No-cost Mass Save Home Energy Assessment: \$400-600 value
- Instant Saving Measures:
 - CFL Light Bulbs
 - Programmable Thermostats
 - Water Saving Devices
- Air Quality Check
- 100% rebated air sealing
- 75% off up to \$2,000 towards approved insulation/weatherization measures
- 0% Interest HEAT loan

Second Action: Consider Solar for Your Home

- Save or Make Money
- Fix your Electricity Costs
- Financing Available
- Replace Fossil-fuel based Energy with Green Energy



SouthCoast Energy Challenge

- 2 years 8,099 participants in SE MA
- 4x membership since February, 2013
- 5637 signed up HEA: 2,147 completed, 497 weatherized
- 2,866 interested in solar: 112 contracts, 61 installations
- 3.5 staff + 60 interns made this happen!
- Summer interns (21 p/t & 3 f/t): 150 events, 487
 shifts = 1,410 outreach hours

Fairhaven Solar Challenge

Launched 5/29

17 contracts, 300 leads
